NBCC Moncton students to present plans for downtown Metro complex

MONCTON - *Downtown Moncton Centre-ville Inc. (DMCI)* and the City of Moncton, in partnership with The New Brunswick Community College, will be presenting conceptual plans for a downtown metro complex at Moncton City Hall Council Chambers on Friday June 6th, 2008 at 11:00 a.m.

As part of their final class project, Civil Engineering Technology Students at NBCC Moncton have created conceptual plans for a downtown metro complex. Four groups will present their proposals to a panel of judges.

Last year, 89% of people surveyed in the City Think exercise conducted by the Times & Transcript and Omnifacts Bristol indicated that they are in favor of building a metro complex in Downtown Moncton. As recent scheduling conflicts have surfaced regarding our hockey teams and the fact that the Moncton Coliseum-Agrena Complex is aging, it is apparent that our growing city needs a state-of-the-art facility to meet the needs of its residents.

DMCI is committed to the continued growth and development of the downtown core. *“A downtown metro complex is a top priority for DMCI. We firmly believe that it is a viable project and these proposals demonstrate the many possibilities that are available”* states DMCI Executive Director, Daniel Allain.
